



CSW School Games Yr. 5 & 6 competition leadership award

The School Games provide an excellent opportunity to engage more and different young people in leadership roles.

This award can be completed and recorded for any number of children in Yr. 5 & 6. We have designed this resource to enable pupils to engage with leadership roles linked to the CSW Virtual School Games offer.

Included in this resource are:

- A student log/checklist that includes a list and explanation of the role's pupils will need to complete.
- Teacher recording sheet.
- Certificates.
- Data collection spreadsheet.
- 2 Badges per form entry across the year group engaged (you will receive these once you return your spreadsheet).

Step by step guide to engaging in the programme

1. Download the resources and share information on the programme with school staff and students.
2. Identify a group or groups of students you would like to complete the award.
3. Pupils to complete the list of 4 roles whilst taking part in one or more of the CSW Virtual School Games competitions. To support this, we have included a leadership page on all of our virtual resources where you will find lots of ideas on the different roles pupils can complete linked to the award.
4. Teacher to log and evidence the roles completed by students.
5. Once complete, please fill out the attached recording spreadsheet and attach photo evidence of a selection of pupils (where possible) completing the award. This should be returned to your SGO.
6. Print and award all pupils that have completed the award with the certificate provided.
7. On receipt of your spreadsheet you will receive 2 badges per form entry. Badges should be awarded to pupils that have shown the School Games values when completing the roles.
8. Share the success of the programme with us on social media.
