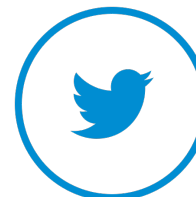

NEXT STEPS

1. Promote this opportunity in your school.
2. Host your school competition.
3. Select your school key stage winners.
4. Record the winning performances - don't forget to include one of your students introducing the performance and saying how it links to one or more of the competition themes.
5. Send in the winning performance videos to your SGO, **before 19th June**.
6. Print and distribute the e-certificate for all of your students that took part. You can **click this link** to access certificate.

RULES

- There is a maximum of one entry per key stage, per school.
- Entries must relate to at least 1 competition theme: **COMMUNITY, FRIENDSHIP, TOGETHERNESS, RECONNECTING.**
- Entries must be no longer than **1 minute 30 seconds** and must include a short (approx. 10 seconds) introduction from one of your students - naming your school and explaining how the performance links to one or more of the competition themes.
- Schools must be able to video all winning performances, and there must be a separate video for each key stage entry.
- Videos of your winning performances for each key stage should be sent to your relevant SGO by **Saturday 19th June**.
- Please ensure that all students involved in being videoed have social media consent - this is important, as the results of the competition will be delivered using social media. Any students that do not have social media consent must not be in the final video that is sent to your SGO, but can take part in any practice performances in your school. If pupils without consent are required to be in the video, please ensure you cover the child's identity before the video is sent to your SGO.
- Your SGO will select a winner from each key stage to go through to the County Finals of the Competition. These selected winners will have the chance to be County Talent Show Champion!
